

Grading Methods

The grading system chosen for a course is fixed until a course revision form changing the grading system is submitted, approved, and processed by Academic Planning and Development. This means that a student may not petition to change to a grade that is not included in the defined grading system for the semester enrolled. In other words, a student may not petition for a CR/NC grade if enrolled in a course that has a grading system of 'Plus-minus letter grade only [N]'. The grading system may not be changed immediately prior to student registration, or during the semester in which the course is offered.

The most commonly used (standard) grading system is 'P' which allows for Plus-minus letter grades and a CR/NC option. The standard grading system is not included in the course description, but all other grading systems must be identified at the end of the course description that appears in the Bulletin.
