

NSSE High-Impact Practices

The **National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE)** measures special extracurricular activities which are linked to learning, retention and engagement.

These activities are known as **High-Impact Practices (HIPs)**.

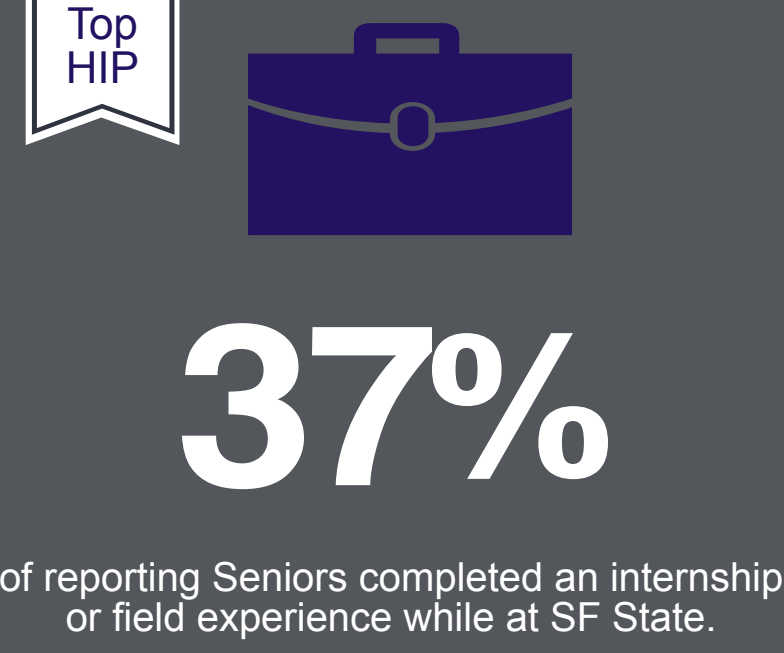
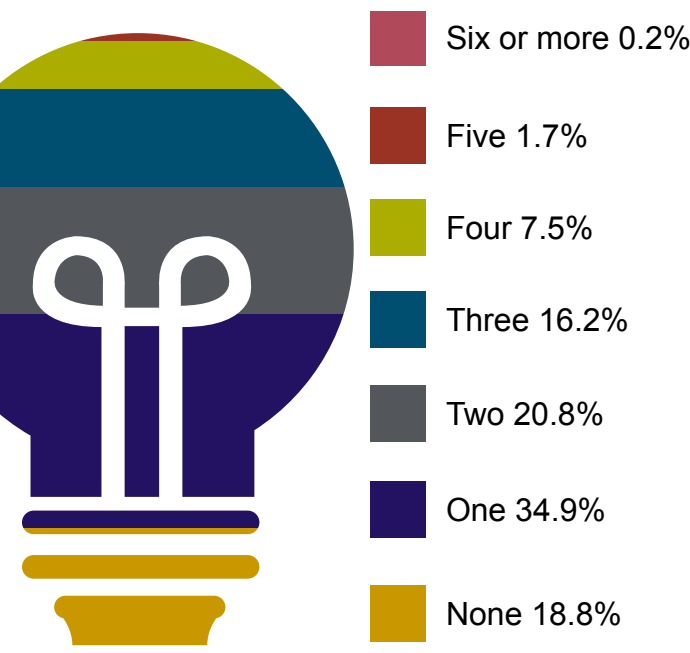
The NSSE includes seven HIPs:

- Research with Faculty
- Culminating Senior Experience
- Service-Learning



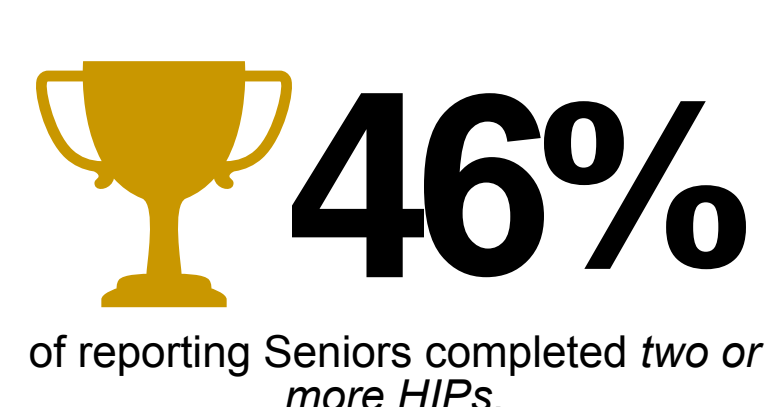
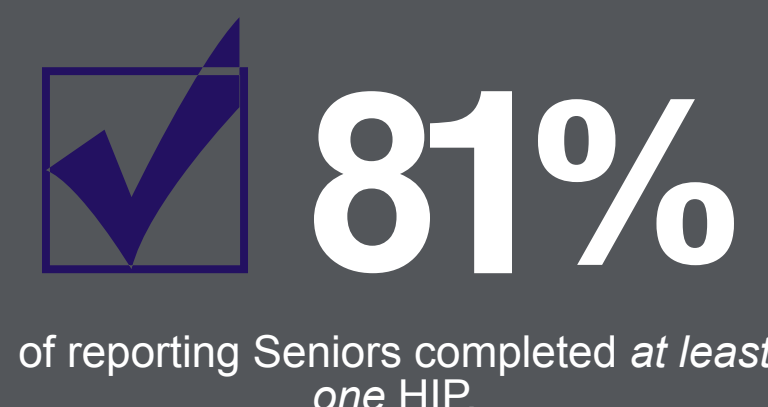
SF State Senior HIP Participation

1,490 Seniors at SF State completed the NSSE in 2017.
 Response rate: 17%.



Why Complete HIPs?

"They demand considerable time and effort, facilitate learning outside of the classroom...participation in these practices can be life-changing" (Kuh, 2008).

Internship or Field Experience

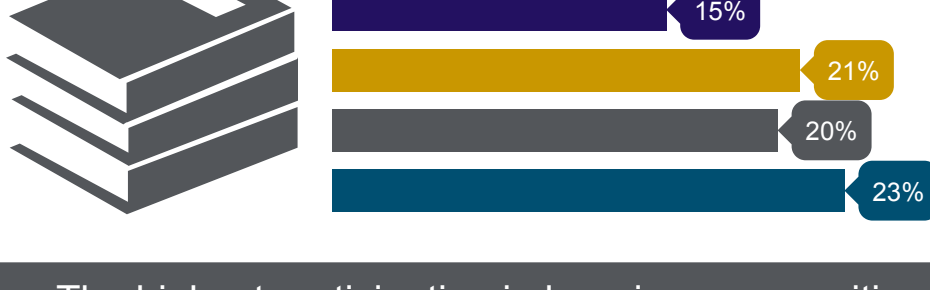


Internship or field experience was reported to be most common in the College of Health & Social Sciences at **63%**.

Leadership in Student Organization

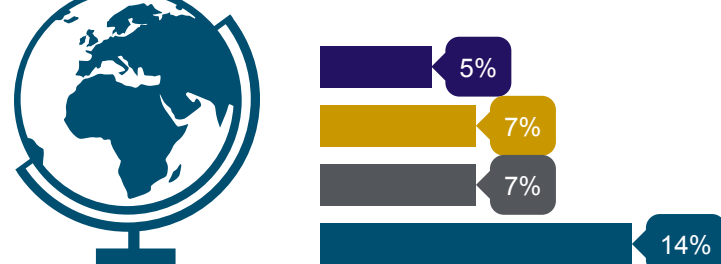


Learning Community

Students from the College of Science and Engineering reported rate of research with faculty at **25%**.

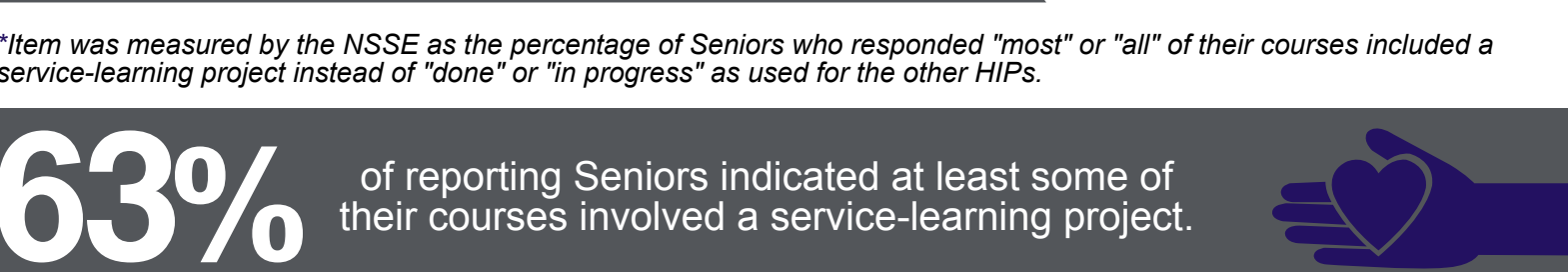
Culminating Senior Experience



Service-Learning Project*



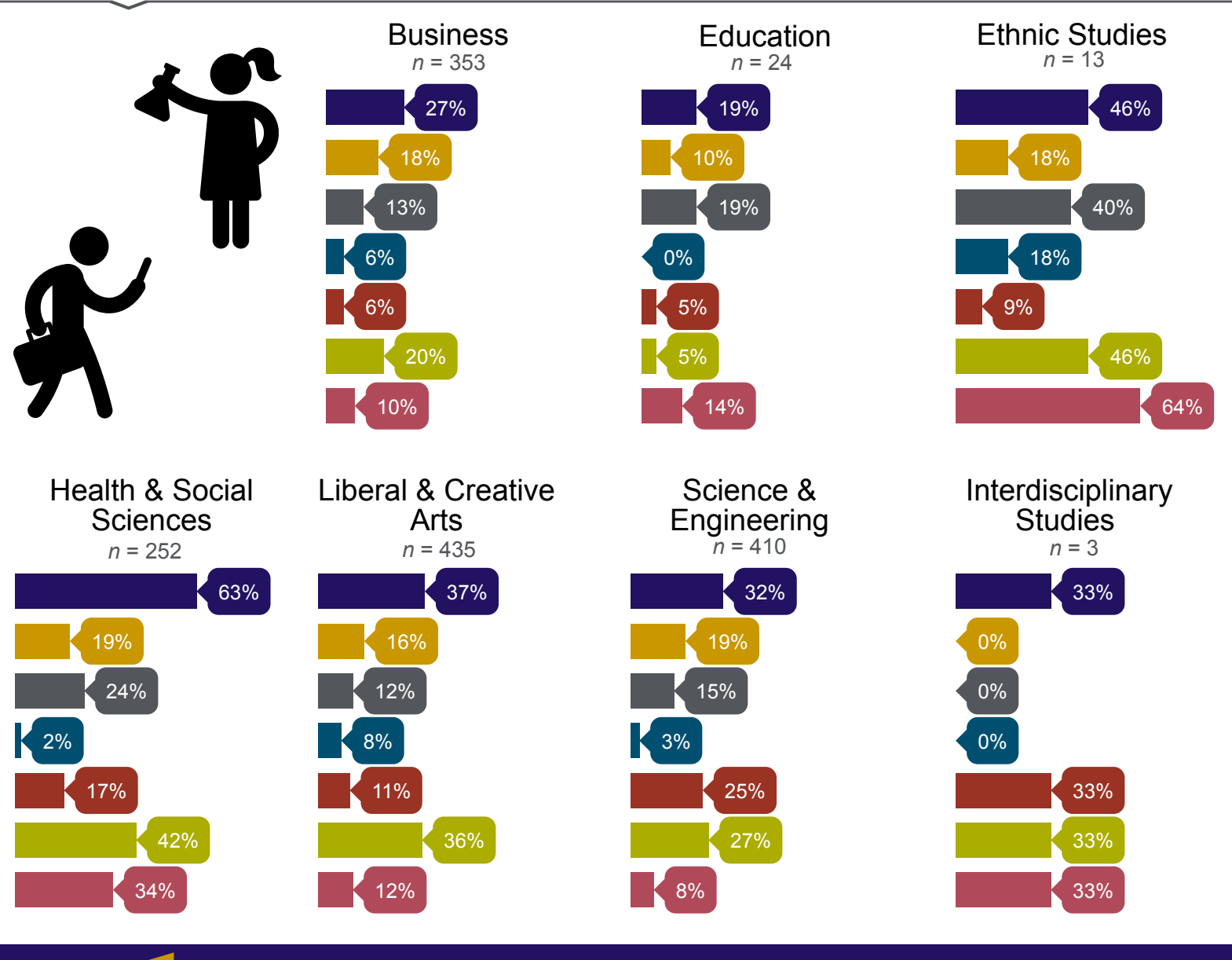
Service-Learning was on par with the other reporting CSUs and higher than the Carnegie and NSSE Cohorts.



How Did HIPs Vary By College?

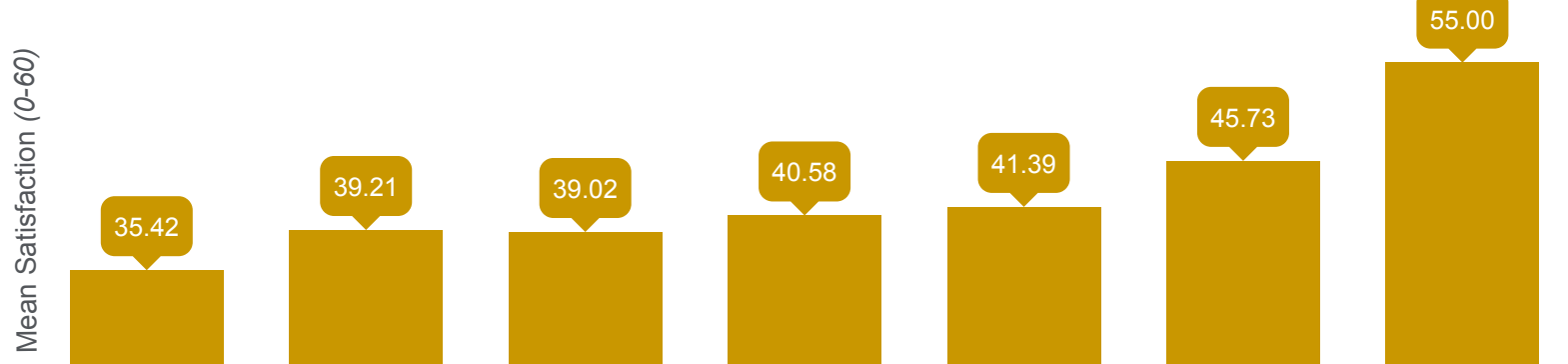
HIP participation varies more among students within an institution than it does between institutions.

Are HIPs Related to Student Satisfaction?

On average, mean satisfaction increased as number of HIPs completed increased.
