### **Minutes**

#### **1. Review and approve minutes from 5/3/12.**

#### **2. Elect chair.**

- Other members expressed willingness to share the burden of attending BRC meetings in Spring 2013.

#### **3. Report from ITL Summer Institute, BRC, and GE assessment ad hoc committee meeting.**

- Robert Collins will scan and post information from ITL Summer Institute.
- Members discussed the draft baccalaureate outcomes proposed by the ITL Summer Institute.
  - The committee discussed the preamble is lofty and unassessable.
  - Robert stated that the ITL faculty asked: what is the breadth of the GE program in terms of the goals?
  - MaryAnn suggested that the preamble might be partially assessable by co-curricular activities such as learning communities.
  - Diane suggested having the level of the learning written into the stem of the learning outcomes: include value and apply language into 3 and 4. Areas 3 and 4 would be assessed at the GE level.
- Amy Kilgard discussed next steps for the draft baccalaureate outcomes.
